



How to get involved!

Attend any meeting! Even if you are not yet on Student Government, anyone is invited and encouraged to attend a meeting to find out what issues Student Government is working on. Senators enjoy and desire input from any student!

Meetings are every other week in the Student Union Cedar room on the first floor, 5:30 p.m. consult the Student Government Web page for the complete schedule.

Open Senate Seats. There may be Senate Seats available if a member has to vacate their position or if one is left unfilled after elections.

Freshman Elections. Any freshman may run in the fall elections that are held in late September-early October. Information will be on the Web Page or by calling 308-865-8523.

Spring Elections. The first week in March each year when annual elections are held. All Senate, and the Presidential/Regent and Vice President positions are open. The elections will be widely advertised and informational sessions will be open for students to attend to gain the needed information to run as a candidate.

Other positions. Student Court: On occasion, students may apply for a Court Justice position as they become vacant. Consult the Student Government Web Site.
